A Day at Camp

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- **8:00/8:30** - Welcome Campers!
- **8:30** - Camp Opening - Our morning routine: we form a circle, welcome the fantastic character of our adventure, greet each other with the Camp Song and Motto, dance, do some stretching, and play a running, high energy game together.
- **9:30** - Activity Time - divided into small age-based groups, each with their own Counsellor, we begin the day's activities. For example, creating the group poster and cheer, artistic and creative projects, storytime, memory games, and more.
- **10:30** - Snack - we all enjoy a snack together.
- **11:00** - Mission of the Day - the most complex game of the day, where, depending on the daily mission, we have specific goals to achieve. Each day features a different game! For example: Dodgeball Tournament, Water Games, Buckets and Squares, Paint War, Town Play, and much more.
- **12:30** - Lunch - picnic on the lawn, with packed lunches brought from home, shared with all Staff.
- **13:00** - Break - a pause from the day's activities, during which children choose what to play, among the available options. Quiet activities include board games, beads and bracelets, and book reading; energetic activities include dancing, gymnastics, and sports.
- **14:30** - Activity Time - divided into small age-based groups, each with their own Counsellor, we conclude the day's activities.
- **15:30** - Final Mission - with one last running game, during which we achieve all our goals of the day to help our fantastic character complete their mission.
- **16:00** - Feedback and Awards - Our closing routine: we form a circle, welcome the fantastic character and share feedback of the day. We officially recognize everyone's achievements with guiding objects, and we say goodbye with the Camp Song and Motto.
- **16:30** - Pick-Up Time - parents arrive to pick up the campers.

- **C Wonder Day Camp is entirely in English.**
- There is no need to know English to participate in our Camp! It is designed to facilitate natural learning and child oriented. For a child, finding themselves immersed in an environment with a different and unfamiliar language can have a strong impact, but we will provide the tools to prepare your children before Camp starts, so that they can have a serene and effective experience!
- We have all the necessary tools to facilitate understanding between the Team of Counsellors and the Campers, even if they speak different languages. We are confident that everyone will be able to understand the requests and actively participate while listening to new sounds.
- To create small groups for activities with their assigned Counsellor, we divide the children by age groups.
